Serving as a successor to Microsoft's Business Productivity Online Suite (BPOS), the service was originally designed to provide hosted e-mail, social networking, collaboration, and cloud storage to teams and businesses. As such, it first included hosted versions of Exchange, Lync, SharePoint, Office Web Apps, along with access to the Microsoft Office 2010 desktop applications on the Enterprise plan. With the release of Office 2013, Office 365 expanded to include new plans aimed at different types of businesses and some focusing on general consumers wanting to use the Office desktop software on a subscription basis.
